We have been through a turbulent 2021, a year like no other in history. At a community level, the pandemic has posed an enormous challenge for us to be even more connected and support each other.

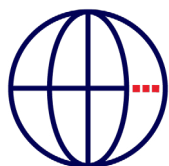

No matter where you are, and when you graduate, this platform is for you.

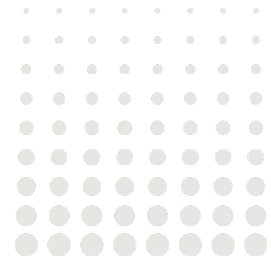

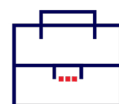

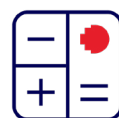

THE ONE LEGACY 2021

Held entirely online for the first time, this year's TEDx RMIT talks attracted its biggest line-up of speakers and audience under the theme "The One Legacy". The 2021 edition broke records with over 1,200 registered participants, 11 speakers, and three sessions held over three days.

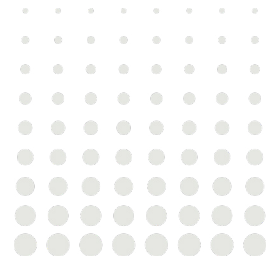
Exclusive activities of the two-day event were highly appreciated in terms of creating networking opportunities for both businesses and individuals, also providing them with relevant industry knowledge.



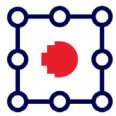
