Alumni E-card

On 10th October 2022, RMIT Vietnam Alumni is glad to introduce the Alumni E-card, serving as an exclusive QR code for alumni to access campuses and use REC & Library services.

The Alumni E-card officially replaces the physical cards from 1 February 2023. During the transition months, when the physical cards are still valid, alumni are recommended to activate e-card for the next campus access.

The Alumni E-card brings various advantages compared to the old physical cards:

More Secure

Each alumnus will have a unique QR code with his/her picture on it. Unless you share it with others, no one could use your alumnus identity to access the campus.

More Sustainable

No more plastic cards will be issued and discarded in the environment.

More Hygienic

The process of creating E-cards and security checks at the campuses entrance will be contactless.

More Connected

The physical card required 4 – 8 weeks to be printed and home-delivered. With an E-card, you can have it within 2 working days.
